Part of this "feeding" is, as Paul did "declare the whole counsel of God" talking about the "Wrath of God".

Look at Romans 1:18--For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hinder the truth in unrighteousness; 19 because that which is known of God is manifest in them; for God manifested it unto them....

Are we disrespectful to God's Word? If so is there any consequences?

In 2 Kings 22:13 Go ye, inquire of Jehovah for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found; for great is the wrath of Jehovah that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us. Beloved, we need to examine all of God's Word to ensure that we do not provoke God unto anger.

Rom.2:7-9 to them that by patience in well-doing seek for glory and honor and incorruption, eternal life: 8 but unto them that are factious, and obey not the truth, but obey unrighteousness, [shall be] wrath and indignation, 9 tribulation

and anguish, upon every soul of man that worketh evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Greek;
